

### **Press Release: Restructuring of Klubb Group**

To overcome recent macroeconomic challenges—including inflation, supply chain disruptions, and shifting market demand—the KLUBB Group is implementing a strategic transformation plan.

This plan is structured around the following key initiatives:

- The reorganization of its production facilities and supply chain.
- A workforce reduction.
- The consolidation of its French aerial work platform operations at the Ferrières-en-Brie plant.
- The sale of its subsidiary, Klubb Engineering.

This strategy is a cornerstone of the continuation plan developed by the company's executive management and the court-appointed administrators (*administrateurs judiciaires*). This plan will shortly be submitted to the Commercial Court for approval, aiming to conclude the judicial rehabilitation proceedings (*procédures de redressement judiciaire*) initiated on February 3, 2026, regarding the companies KLUBB GROUP, KLUBB, KLUBB France, and KLUBB ENGINEERING.
